The Story of *LOLA MONTEZ*

The story of this musical is based on historical fact. The “Spanish Dancer” *Lola Montez*, Mistress of Ludwig 1 of Bavaria, and a reigning beauty of mid-Victorian Europe, visited Australia in 1855 – 1856 and performed elaborate dance numbers in many cities, including Ballarat (as it was then spelt). Lola’s “Spider Dance” was rewarded with a hail of nuggets – the miners swarmed onto the stage in approbation. Following a pungent newspaper criticism, she publicly horsewhipped the Editor of “The Ballarat Times”, (let modern critics beware). *Lola* left Australia under the management of an American, for further performances in the United States.

Three young Australians collaborated in writing *Lola Montez*. Peter Stannard wrote the music, Peter Benjamin the lyrics, and Alan Burke the book. The authors have, we believe, succeeded in writing a clever, witty and fun musical. We are proud to present our first all-Australian full-scale musical.

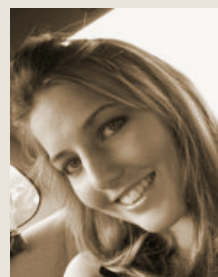
**Sam Vanderberg

NEPTUNE and LOLA

NEPTUNE is the eighth and farthest planet from the Sun and was discovered on September 23, 1846. It was the first planet found by Arithmetical prediction rather than empirical observation. Unexpected changes in the orbit of Uranus led Alexis Bouvard, to recognize that its orbit was subject to gravitational perturbation by an unknown planet. Strangely enough Bouvard, a Frenchman, was in France at the same time as Madame Montez and thus may well have known her acquaintance or perhaps more. Could Lola Montez's vexations been a factor in driving Bouvard to engage upon the no doubt maddening set Arithmetical tribulations necessary to deduce an unseen planet's existence? It is indeed 'possible'. To this observer it seems to add up at any rate! Perhaps the mystical and the preposterous have conspired together to come full circle as 'Neptune Productions' now presents 'Lola Montez'.

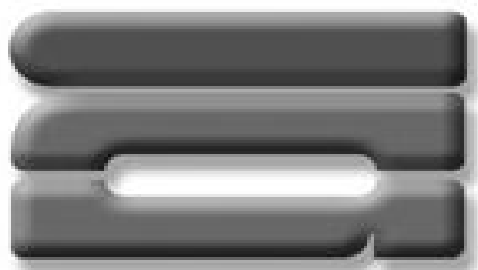
